


One DoorPac protects one door.

How to 'energise' your FloodSax®




Remove outer packaging. Then open up the vacuum- sealed bag and remove the FloodSax®.




Energise your FloodSax®. This can be done by soaking the FloodSax® with water until they are fully expanded. This should take 2 to 3 minutes.

- You can soak your FloodSax® in the sink, a bucket or wheelbarrow
- You can use a hosepipe or watering can
- You can use rain water

How to build your wall of FloodSax®



After 'energising', place the one long FloodSax® against the base of the door.



And then build a wall on top by vertically overlapping the other 'energised' FloodSax®.
