TEE update for July CPC Meeting

* The CPC are continuing to engage actively with the **Travelling Light team** as one way towards improving rural transport links for the community which includes both residents and visitors. Travelling Light continue to run a local travel survey with the aim of using the data to lobby local and national government and whoever wields influence (and money) to improve local bus and train services. One possible outcome could be the establishment of a reliable bus link between Castleton and the train service at Hope station. This is linked to the idea of introducing a travel hub at Hope. Attended Travelling Light update in Hope this month to hear about current developments.

Meeting with some of TL team prior to their attendance at Community cafe to discuss progress made on survey. Results of consultation will be shared with CPC. Advice sought on writing directly to bus companies and other key stakeholders such as Derbyshire Council, High Peak Borough Council, PDNPA etc.

TL chatted to residents at the July Community Cafe making sure some of residents views were represented beyond the online survey. Responses will be shared with CPC along with survey results. Positive feedback on their attendance and communication at the July Community Cafe.

Recommendation to CPC:

To maintain support to the Travelling Light team and the objective of improving local transport links for the community, Draft letter to DCC and Bus Service Improvement Wider Stakeholder Group to be approved by CPC. Project leader of TL has asked the CPC if they would like to send a representative of CPC to an online meeting of this group on Thursday September 28 at 3.00pm. CPC to approve and nominate representative if we wish to be part of this group which also comprises rail companies.

*Refreshing dog poo signs continues as necessary but with an emphasis on the potential health hazards to individuals and particularly young children. This is the Derbyshire County Council signage. The CPC are keen to make sure that residents know they cannot monitor this throughout the village and also rely on residents to be vigilant and try and report dog fouling to High Peak Borough Council's reporting portal.-: www.highpeak.gov.uk/report

.*Further TEE events,

An e-bike demonstration in the village (others have been held in Bamford and Hope). CPC have written to both Travelling Light contact and Cllr Farrell re advice. The latter advises us to decide on a date but to be aware of administrative issues in organising such an event such as insurance costs.

Introducing a Repair cafe CPC in partnership with Edale Parish Council was approved at the June CPC. Suggestions from councillors and post-it suggestions from previous events to remain on file (these include a repair cafe, clothes swap, renewables and lobbying, single use plastics, plant diets, Wifi in Village Hall).
